Position Description Applications are invited for an Academic Professional position in Mathematics and Statistics beginning July 1, 2024. Candidates in all areas of mathematics and statistics are encouraged to apply. Although this is a non-tenure track position, it will be renewable each year for the first five years, subject to annual evaluation and a third-year review, and it has the potential for promotion to senior academic professional after five years and then to principal senior academic professional.

Academic Professional is a 12-month appointment. The responsibilities for the position will include a) teaching, enhancement, and coordination of courses, b) management of the computer laboratory in which the interactive components of courses are conducted, c) creating an environment of academic and professional excellence for students and educational team members, d) maintaining professional relationships with students and colleagues, and e) working on campus 5 days per week whenever the University is open.
